Net accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior in her early years of life while attending church with her late grandmother, Catherine Rodgers. Her side smile and twinkle in her eye would tell you that you're loved. Antionette is survived by her common law husband of 36 years, William Lobdell; her sisters, Linda (Roderick) Ross of Charlotte, NC, Marsha Rodgers of Peoria, IL, and Janice (Derrick) Parker of Dunlap, IL, and numerous nieces and nephews, aunts, and uncles.
