In a beautiful twist of fate, this sacred day also marks the birthday of her eldest sister—a divine reminder that love and legacy are forever intertwined.

Born on August 11, 1973, in Chicago, Illinois, to Edward Earl Williams and Everlina Winder, Brenda was a beacon of warmth and generosity from the very beginning. She attended Peoria Manual High School and later found her calling in the medical field, dedicating years of compassionate service as a Direct Support Professional with Trinity Services INC. and providing private care through Addus. Her work was more than a job—it was an extension of her nurturing heart.

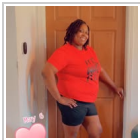
