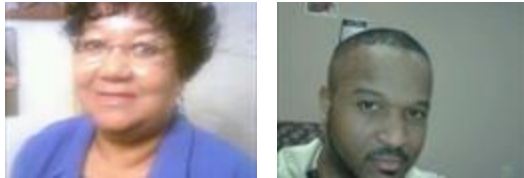
To overcome our pain of heart we remember how our uncle George was a kind and generous man- a gentle giant, if you will. His laughter was very infectious and could brighten up any room.
