Rev. Grady Lee Barnett, 77, of Peoria departed this life into God's heavenly gates on April 2, 2021 at Aperion Care Morton Villa at 7:46 a.m. Rev. Grady was born on April 29, 1943 in Scott, MS to Willie B. and Octivia Barnett, they precede him. Rev. Grady Barnett attended Nuggent Center in Scott, MS. In 1969 he moved to Peoria where he founded Gailee Missionary Baptist Church and Pastored for 30 years. He married Ladon Chillton on December 24, 1972, she survives. Rev.
