Hilbert H. Burrell 97, of Peoria, IL passed away on January 03, 2017 at 4:06 a.m. at OSF St. Francis Medical Center. He was born on November 26, 1919 in Chicago IL to the late Virgil and Elizabeth Burrell. Hilbert married Canary (Jones) Burrell on October 26, 1942 in Peoria she survives.

Hilbert lost his parents at a young age and was raised by his grandmother, Annie Burrell.
