Mable Lee Hanson-Hoskins (affectingly known as Lee Lee) ,91, passed away in Peoria, Tuesday, December 4, 2018 at Heddington Oaks Nursing Home. She was born May 26, 1927 to Emma Phillips Hanson and Henry Hanson in Holmes County, Tchula, MS. Mable had a very nurturing spirit which led her to become a Foster Grandparents through PCCEO, Inc. She had a love for children like no other, in her own words "I love rocking my babies".

She had a zest for life and style; she loved to dress and had to have the most stylish hair styles at all times. When she entered a room her smile would light up a room. She never met a stranger, she loved all.
