Mosell Wallace, 71, of Peoria passed away on January 17, 2020 at OSF St. Francis Medical Center. He was born to Mozell Wallace and Alma Conwell Wallace on September 20, 1948, both preceded him in death.

Mosell loved to work on cars, go fishing, and just being outdoors was his tranquility time. He joined the U.S. Marine Corps in 1967 and served until 1970.
